

Workshop #2: TRANS & GENDER DIVERSE 101

Understanding The Gender Spectrum

Outcomes:

- To develop a deeper understanding of the terminology surrounding the Trans and Gender Diverse (TGD) communities.
- To develop empathy for the day-to-day experiences of TGD people in our society.
- To become familiar with the latest research findings on TGD people in Australia.
- To feel confident when using / introducing / asking for gender pronouns.
- To learn how to manage honest language errors.
- To learn practical ways of becoming a stronger TGD ally.
- To receive answers to burning questions relating to the TGD and broader LGBTIQ+ communities.

Workshop Summary:

This interactive and conversational workshop provides a supportive space for participants to explore the terminology and everyday experiences of LGBTIQ+ people in our society. The content draws from current research and the workshop format flows between presenting, group discussions and breakaway activities. We use a strengths-based learning framework to ensure participants can engage with the content in a safe, productive and judgement-free environment.

After becoming familiar with the language and research surrounding the TGD and broader LGBTIQ+ communities, participants have the opportunity to learn firsthand from the lived experiences of a TGD individual, growing their empathy for the unseen, day-to-day experiences of members of this community.

Through a series of exercises and group discussions, participants will then explore practical ways in which they can support the TGD people in their lives and become even stronger allies.

Our patient and experienced facilitators will encourage participants to make the most of this unique opportunity by asking the questions they may not feel comfortable asking elsewhere throughout the workshop.
